Vessel History

WOLF is a classic 74' gaff rigged topsail schooner built in 1982-1983 in Panama City, Florida by Master builder Willis Ray and Finbar Gittelman, Admiral First Sea Lord of the Conch Republic. Designed by Merit Walter, the **WOLF** is a Norfolk Rover class steel hull schooner and Admiral Finbar, First Sea Lord of the Conch Republic serves as her master.

WOLF is home ported at Safe Harbour Marina in Stock Island Key West and is owned and operated by Key West Packet Lines, Inc. Designated the Flagship of the Conch Republic and the Florida Keys, **WOLF** is patterned after the blockade runners that plied the waters of the Florida Straits, Caribbean Sea and Atlantic Ocean in the 19th century.

A Key West icon, the **WOLF** has been featured in numerous publications, films and documentaries; and truly symbolizes the essence of that "island spirit" which draws visitors from around the world.

WOLF is known for her humanitarian *Mission of Mercy Sails* and has taken donated relief supplies to Port Antonio (1987), Guanaja, Honduras (1998), Hope Town, Abaco Bahamas (2004), West End, Grand Bahama (2005) and La Gonave, Haiti (2010.) In 1998, **WOLF** transported members of the Interfaith Pilgrimage of the Middle Passage to Cuba on their journey of retracing that ancient route of slavery.

WOLF attends numerous seaport festivals and special events and the 2012 Summer East Coast Ambassador Voyage included visits to Beaufort, NC, New Bern & River Dunes, NC; Baltimore, & Eastport, MD; Portsmouth & Smithfield, VA; New London & Groton, CT; Cape May, NJ; Bristol, RI and other historic ports of call. Over the years, **WOLF** has also traveled pirate festival and island festivals in Green Turtle Cay, Bahamas (2006 & 2007); Cayman Islands (2000 & 2003); Port Antonio, Port Royal, Ochos Rios & Montego Bay, Jamaica (2002) and Mobile, AL (2003.)
